PASTOR'S PONDERINGS

"The Lord your God is with you, the Mighty Warrior who saves. He will take great delight in you; in his love he will no longer rebuke you, but will rejoice over you with singing" (Zephaniah 3:17, NIV).

Can you imagine God singing? The Hebrew phrase "he will rejoice over you with singing" can also be translated literally as "he rejoices over you with a shout of joy." God rejoices over you with loud singing. As God the Father is One who holds His daughter Jerusalem and sings joyfully in her presence. Just as a loving parent cradles a child and sings out of love, so God's song over God's people is born of great love. WOW!

These words come to a people, after a time of hardship. Here our loving Lord dries the people's tears, comforts their hearts, and welcomes them to a new world. This is the message of Advent. It is the promise of intimate fellowship and communion between God and Israel which is the foundation of God's joy in humanity and humanity's joy in God.

Advent's intention is to awaken the most profound and basic knowledge within us, specifically, the knowledge of God, who stepped through time and space, into human history to become a child because of love. Advent's invitation is to rehearse the great history of God's amazing love toward us and to awaken to the present reality of life's fresh longing for God with us.

Advent is the opportunity to reflect within; always knowing that we are more than the sum of our actions and our days, our thoughts and moods; knowing that we wait for the return of Christ in glory to consummate his eternal kingdom.

Advent gives us the space and place to recover our dreams of a world filled with love, a world filled with joy, a world filled with hope, and a world filled with peace. It is a time between already and not yet. It is a time of great expectation and of waiting, of anticipation, of knowing and not knowing. It is a time filled with the holy presence of God. It is our time with God.

During this Season of Advent, take refuge in God. Put your hope on the righteousness of Christ. Allow the Lord God to embrace you, right where you are. Rest in God's arms. Listen for God's voice. God is singing. The Lord, the King of kings, rejoices over you with gladness and exults over you with loud singing. God loves... God loves you.

"May the sounds of Advent stir a longing in your people, O God. Come again to set us free from the dullness of routine and the poverty of our imaginations. Break the patterns which bind us to small commitments and to the stale answers we have given to questions of no importance. Let the Advent trumpet blow, let the walls of our defenses crumble, and make a place in our lives for the freshness of your love, well-lived in the Spirit, and still given to all who know their need and dare receive it.
