DECEMBER FINANCE REPORT

If you have not already received a copy of the proposed budget for 2026, they are available in the Sanctuary or by requesting one from Ed Szmul and myself, Bonnie Nadig.

This year's budget was particularly difficult to formulate since we currently are not paying a pastor's salary or the benefits. We do, however, pay our guest speakers. While the budget for 2026 is looking pretty good, we must keep in mind that there is the possibility we will be back to paying a new pastor sometime during 2026, although it will be a part time position. The exact amount for the new salary will be determined based on whether the parsonage is part of the package. When we are in that position, we will share all information with the congregation. The <u>budget vote</u> will take place after our regular church service on 12/14/25.

In the meantime, please consider filling out a pledge card to give us some idea of what we might expect as income. Pledges can be returned in the basket in the front of the church or by mailing or placing them in the Treasurer's Box outside of the church office.

Please feel free to contact any member of the Finance Committee with any questions regarding the proposed budget. Thank you in advance for supporting God's work at Harrisena.
